First and foremost we are all here to have fun, however these items must be agreed upon by all vendors.

Our market is open Saturdays, June through September 9 am till noon. By completing and signing this form, I am committing to be present as a vendor with products for sale at least 2(prefer 3 or 4) weeks per month during June, July and Aug 2011. Dates beyond these are strictly voluntary-no commitment beyond August is required, however appreciated. There will be no charge for weekly Farmers Market booth space if commitment met. For those wishing to vend sporadically throughout the summer, there is a \$5 per week charge payable prior to set up.

For weekly Farmers Market vendors: I agree to be ready to sell by 9 a.m. and stay until noon on these weeks. (I understand I am to bring my own tables, chairs, table coverings, signage, tags, bags, change, canopy's etc. and remove these items by 12:30 each Saturday following the market. This includes unsold merchandise. I agree not to bring rummage sale or flea market items to be sold at either event.

Since we advertise "locally" grown, all items are required to be grown, raised, built or made locally within 50 miles of Markleville.

I understand I am required to abide by Town laws and Park and Farmers Market rules. I will not use foul language, discuss or display inappropriate items etc. This is a family event and we have children in attendance and want this to be a positive environment and wholesome learning experience. If this item is not upheld-you will be asked to vacate the park.

The Markleville Farmers Market Co-op was established to supply farm fresh produce, fruits, plants, flowers, etc. to the local community and to boost the local economy. We are not in competition with other vendors-we will all work together in a friendly, helpful and community based manner and provide the community with our finest, locally grown items. Prices should be visibly posted on all items for sale.

The Town of Markleville, Markleville Park, Adams Township or any board members or employees of these entities, or the Markleville Farmers Market coordinators /volunteers are not responsible, nor will be held responsible for any theft, personal or property injury, accidents or negative outcomes as a result of the Farmers Market. This is a volunteer event.
