

ORDINANCE NO. 2017- 2


AN ORDINANCE CONTROLLING DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS


WHEREAS, the Town Council of Markleville, Indiana, believes that an ordinance regulating discharge of firearms would be of benefit to the Town, and would improve the quality of life in the Town.


THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Town Council of Markleville, Indiana, as follows:

- I. No person shall discharge a firearm within or into the Town of Markleville, Indiana except:
  - A. By any authorized law enforcement officer as part of his or her duty
  - B. By any person who has reason to believe that he or she shall suffer an imminent injury to his or her person or property and as a consequence discharges the firearm in self-defense
- II. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined a sum not to exceed one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for each offense.
