

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RESTRICTION ON VEHICLE AND TRUCK WEIGHT ON STREETS

WHEREAS, the use of All vehicles and trucks under this ordinance shall be regulated for the best interest of all citizens.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Town Council of the Town of Markleville, State of Indiana, to exercise its powers in order to regulate the weight of vehicles and trucks on the public streets. That the regulation is to assist in the safety and overall best interest of the street conditions in Markleville.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Markleville, State of Indiana:

1. That the restriction applies to vehicles and trucks with an empty weight limit over five thousand pounds (5,000 lbs.).

2. This ordinance shall restrict and not allow the operation of any vehicles or trucks with an empty weight limit over five thousand pounds.

3. That this restriction on vehicles and trucks shall be for the entire town street of Maple Street and for County Road 300 East(South of State Road 38 to the town limit.

4. Any violation of the conditions imposed by this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per occurrence.

5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect in accordance with Indiana law. All ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.
